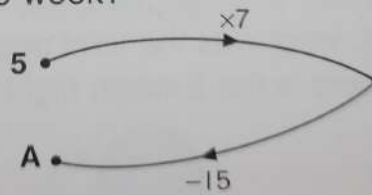





- The difference between two numbers is 11. The smaller number is 19. What is the larger number?
